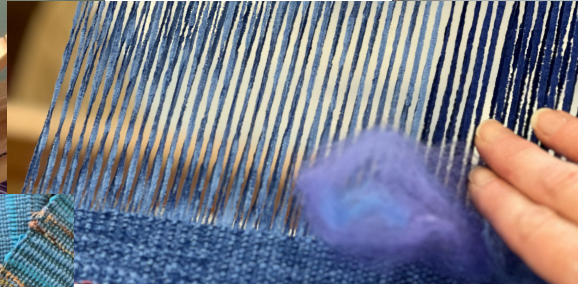
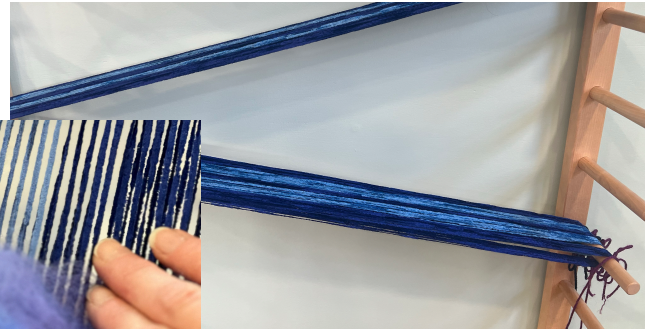


Making Nantucket Blues



Samantha Wilde, in her weaving studio (with baby #6 helping out!), weaves on two different looms, a Saori and a 48" Ashford Rigid Heddle loom, to create the signature Nantucket Blues scarves and wraps.



The creation of each piece is a multi-step process: choosing colors, warping the board, sleying the reed, dressing the loom, weaving, finishing, washing and trimming! There is no pattern, plan or predetermined design. Each piece is completely original and the sky is the limit in terms of variation of color, texture, length and width.



Talk about slow fashion! Each piece can take up to nine hours of work and incorporates repurposed fabric as well as yarn making every scarf and wrap a unique piece of upcycled wearable art. Nantucket Blues scarves and wraps, inspired by the fictional store, Nantucket Blues, in Nancy Thayer's novel, "The Summer We Started Over," bring the beauty, magic, and charm of Nantucket to you, so you can be wrapped up in the spirit and colors of the island.
